


March 2026 Ukraine, UK

We have mentioned before how gangs of military police are going around Ukraine grabbing men off the streets and forcing them into the military. There is no conscientious exemption. We asked for your prayers for brother Alexei, to whom this has happened. And for his very elderly mum, sister Lena, who lives high up in an apartment block, often without electricity and water, struggling with blindness, dementia and other health issues. Our brother has sent us a photo of how he is, and of course our prayers must be with him that he can live within his conscience for the Lord in such a very difficult situation.


After playing and singing so well for us at the Carrotty Wood retreat, brother Julian met up with brother Duncan in Manchester and they drove further north to baptize JASON in his bathtub at home near Burnley. He had been searching for Bible truth for a long time after an extraordinary life and after some time studying the Bible he came to the conclusion he had to be baptized into Jesus rather than the trinity, having come across our material online. He had researched the errors of Nicea and was very grateful to have found us.



We've been having chats for a while with one of our online followers, JANE, in Nottingham. She had quit Jehovah's Witnesses and spent years just reading the Bible on her own, desperately wanting to be baptized but not willing to submit to baptism into a church organization whose beliefs and culture she didn't fully share. So it was "of God" that she encountered us online. We took sisters Faith and Marie with us from the Jarvis Avenue ecclesia and had a wonderful time with her, baptizing her in her bath tub, despite her struggling with COPD.
